

# EVERY EYE SHALL SEE HIM

---

Rev 1:7 Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

Note: Christ's coming takes place at the end of the Great Tribulation according to Matt 24 and Rev 19. This event has not taken place yet, it is future. The Watchtower's claim that Christ returned in 1914 is not the rendering of any of these scriptures given in support of their context.

A warning is given here to beware of those who say His coming is not visible.

Matt 24:26 Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he (Christ when He returns) is in the desert; go not forth: behold, he is in the secret chambers (His coming was not visible); believe it not.

27 For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; (everyone shall see it) so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

## **CAUTION!!!**

**“So it was in 1914 that Jesus returned invisibly, without public fanfare and with only his faithful servants being aware of his return.”<sup>1</sup>**

Acts 17:11 These were more noble (the Bereans) than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.
